EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES:

The construction industry is booming, especially in Marion County, and the need for skilled workers is growing. Employment of construction workers and helpers is projected to grow 13 percent from 2016 to 2026, faster than the average for all occupations*. Placement support with local employers will be available.

SALARY RANGE:

The median annual wage for construction laborers and helpers was \$32,230 in May 2016. *

INDUSTRY CERTIFICATIONS:

By completing this course, our students will be prepared to receive their NCCER Blue Card and for greater employment opportunities in one of the faster-growing industries in the United States**. Students who complete this course and earn



their NCCER Blue Card MAY receive 6 months credit towards a Construction Apprenticeship Program. The cost for taking the certification examination is included in the program's total fee.
