Our Construction Basics class will be held at our new MTC East Campus facility starting in June of 2019. This class will feature the OSHA and portions of NCCER curriculum designed specifically by NCCER, and will be taught by a certified instructor. The National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER) is nationally recognized by industry and government as the training, assessment, certification and career development standard for construction and maintenance craft professionals.

EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES:

The construction industry is booming, especially in Marion County, and the need for skilled workers is growing. Employment of construction workers and helpers is projected to grow 13 percent from 2016 to 2026, faster than the average for all occupations*. Placement support with local employers will be available.

SALARY RANGE :

The median annual wage for construction laborers and helpers was \$32,230 in May 2016. *

INDUSTRY CERTIFICATIONS:

By completing this course, our students will receive OSHA 10-hour Construction Safety cards and basic construction skills training for greater employment opportunities in one of the faster-growing industries in the United States**. The cost for taking the OSHA course is included in the program's total fee.
