One additional, but incredibly critical, piece of information you need to know, impacts those who are unemployed and trying to set up or submit claims for Reemployment Assistance, commonly known as Unemployment Insurance or Unemployment Compensation.

We know that, due to unprecedented demand, there have been delays and frustrations for those attempting to file claims online.

The Reemployment Assistance (RA) program, which provides temporary wage benefits for those out of work through no fault of their own, is administered by the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO). Those frustrated in filing an online application for services now have the option of mailing in a paper application. You will find links to online and paper options on our website, careersourceclm.com, on our COVID-19 updates page, accessible at the top of every page on our site, as well as our Candidates and Reemployment Assistance

pages. You will also see a Reemployment Assistance Quick Link on our Home Page. You may also access at DEO's Keep Floridians First site at www.floridajobsresources.com/.

Additionally, work search, online work registration and waiting week requirements

have been waived for Reemployment Assistance applications.
